
Soil Densification

Bridge construction begins with foundation work. Underlying soils, as deep as 12 metres, have been strengthened with a soil densification process. This work will ensure post construction settlement is minimized.



The closure below will be in place until approximately June 2009.



Bridge Construction Over Chilliwack Creek Diversion



The pre-cast concrete girders are placed using a 500 ton capacity mobile crane. The Chilliwack Creek Division bridge is the shortest of two waterway bridges.
