

An alias address can be applied for in situations such as:

- A permitted additional residence on a property (i.e. coach house, manufactured home)
- Business license purposes (i.e. commercial spaces, tenant mailing).

It will allow you to receive mail/deliveries as well as service providers to hook up phone, cable, hydro, etc. It will also ensure the address is sent to be registered with Emergency Services (E911, Fire Department, RCMP). Once your application is submitted it will be reviewed to ensure it meets the proper requirements (i.e. an authorized dwelling, correct permits, historical background) and we will contact you once approved.

Please note: If your application involves a newly completed building/under construction, the new address is only able to be created once your project is complete (i.e. your Building Inspector grants your Occupancy/Final permit).
