DEVELOPMENT VARIANCE PERMIT DVP00867**

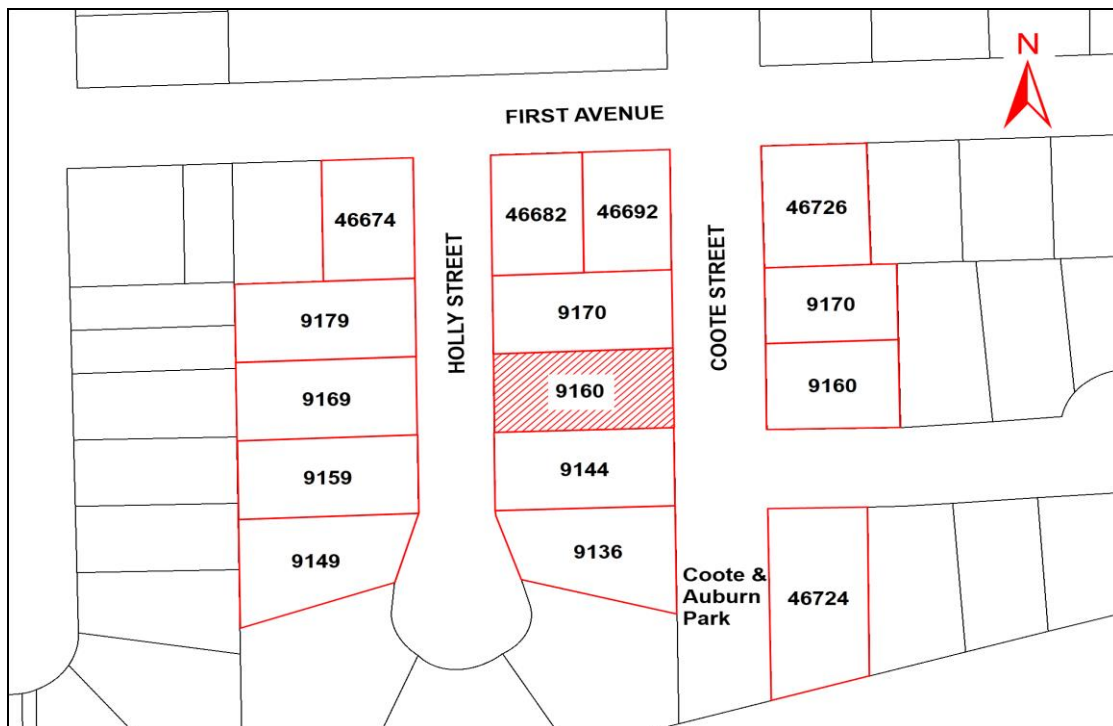
**Location:** 9160 Holly Street

**Applicants:** Derek & Jennifer Yodogawa

**Purposes:** To rezone the subject property, as shown on the map below, from an R1-A (One Family Residential) Zone to an R1-C (One Family Residential - Accessory) Zone to facilitate the construction of an Accessory Dwelling Unit in the form of a coach house.

A Development Variance Permit application to vary the permitted lot coverage for urban ancillary structures within the proposed R1-C Zoned property from 70m<sup>2</sup> to 83m<sup>2</sup> is being considered concurrently with the Rezoning application to facilitate the construction of a coach house and retain two small existing sheds within the subject property.
