
TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the City of Chilliwack will hold a Public Information Meeting, as noted above, on the following item:

## 1. DEVELOPMENT VARIANCE PERMIT DVP00868

Location: 46013 Weeden Drive (within City Road Right of Way)

- Applicant: Cypress Land Services
- Purpose: To vary Section 5.14 of the Zoning Bylaw to facilitate the replacement of an existing light pole with a new free standing 12m tall light standard with wireless telecommunications equipment on the top and an equipment cabinet at the base of the pole, on the subject property, as shown on the map below. The Zoning Bylaw requires telecommunication antennae to be attached to an existing building or structure; as such, the installation of a free standing tower triggers the need for a Development Variance Permit application. The proposed pole installation is to provide wireless services for the area.

Property Owners and any tenants in occupation of lands directly affected by the permit and within 30 metres of the lands, as shown above, will have an opportunity to be heard at the Public Information Meeting or, if you are unable to attend, you may provide a written submission, **including your full name and address**, to the City Clerk's Office <u>no later than 4:00 p.m. on the date of the Public Information Meeting</u>. All submissions will be recorded and form part of the official record of the Meeting.

This proposed Development Variance Permit may be inspected between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding holidays, from **Wednesday, June 21, 2017 to Tuesday, July 4, 2017**, both inclusive, in the Office of the City Clerk at City Hall, 8550 Young Road, Chilliwack, BC.
