### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

#### TOILET REBATE PROGRAM EFFECTIVE APRIL 06, 2010

- Available only for City of Chilliwack residents on City's water supplies.
- Toilet(s) being replaced must have a flushing volume of 13 litres or greater. You **MUST** indicate old toilet flush volume on application.
- Applicant must be registered property owner
- For single-family, detached houses\* built prior to September 30, 2005
- New toilets must be CSA or Warnock Hersey Certified and must not exceed 6 litres per flush
- New toilet must have a maximum performance rating (MaP) of 350 or higher
- Not eligible for toilets replaced as part of any construction activity which requires a building permit.
- The toilet must have been purchased and installed after April 06, 2010. The rebate is not retroactive.

Applicants will be treated on a first-come, first-served basis until the funding is exhausted. Limit of two (2) toilet rebates per single-family dwelling.

\* Multi-family (condominiums and apartments), industrial, commercial, and other non-residential properties are not eligible at this time.

\* Multi-family (townhouses and duplexes) and detached home strata are eligible; however, **additional conditions apply**. Contact the Engineering Department for more information.

### NOW IS A GREAT TIME TO REPLACE YOUR TOILET.

The City of Chilliwack has an excellent source of great tasting water from the Sardis-Vedder Aquifer. Using less water saves energy, saves money, and conserves our limited supply. To help us conserve water and sustainably manage this precious resource, the City of Chilliwack is offering a rebate of \$50 when you purchase and install a low-flow toilet to replace your water guzzling 13+ litre per flush (LPF) model. A low-flow toilet has a flush volume equal to or less than 6 LPF.

Most homes built before 2005 have inefficient toilets that waste water. In an average home, toilets represent 30% of indoor water use. Converting to a 6 LPF toilet can save between 80 and 100 litres of water per toilet per day. **SAVE WATER AND SAVE MONEY**; there's no reason not to switch.

### DO 6 LPF TOILETS REALLY WORK?

**YES!** These toilets are designed to perform as reliably as any large volume toilet, but with less than half the water. A maximum performance (MaP) rating of 350 or higher is cited as a minimum performance threshold for meeting customer expectation in waste removal efficiency. Toilets with higher MaP scores have better performance. Only toilets with MaP ratings of 350 and higher are eligible for the rebate.

### DOES YOUR TOILET QUALIFY FOR THE REBATE PROGRAM?

Look for a stamp on your toilet to find the number of litres per flush. It's printed on the inside or rear of the tank, on the tank label, which is on the top of the bowl, or on the flush valve. If you can't find a stamp, measure the tank to calculate the volume (length (cm) x width (cm) x water depth (cm) ÷ 1000 = volume in litres). If the flush volume is 13 litres (3.5 gal) or greater, it qualifies!

**☆ YOU MUST INDICATE YOUR OLD TOILET'S FLUSHING VOLUME ON YOUR APPLICATION TO RECEIVE REBATE.**

### HERE'S WHAT YOU NEED TO DO:

1. Determine if you are eligible (refer to Eligibility Criteria)
2. Purchase your new low-flow toilet with a maximum performance (MaP) rating of 350 or higher. **Submit your original sales receipt OR plumber's invoice.**
3. Submit **photo of your new toilet(s)** installed.
4. Bring your old toilet(s) to Bailey Sanitary Landfill (You are responsible for unloading your toilet. Your scale ticket is proof of drop off.) **Keep your scale ticket to obtain rebate.**
5. **OR**  
Submit a photo of the **old toilet removed with the tank broken.**

Approved rebate cheques are mailed within 6 - 8 weeks of receiving applications.

### DECLARATION (signature required)

I have read and understood the terms of the program and understand the City of Chilliwack is not responsible for the installation or functioning of the toilet(s).

The City of Chilliwack reserves the right to inspect or verify that toilets have been installed. Any rebate application may be subject to onsite inspection or verification by the City of Chilliwack.

### CHECK LIST (incomplete applications will not be approved)

To ensure your application will be processed, be sure you have completed the following:

- determined you are eligible for the rebate (refer to eligibility criteria)
- completed application form (all questions answered)
- signed and dated application (in space provided below)
- included original sales receipt (to be returned to you) **or** scan of the original, if emailing
- included Bailey Landfill scale ticket **or** photo of old toilet removed with tank broken
- provided photo of new toilet in place
