Nomination Period

from 9:00 am on Tuesday, September 4, 2018
to 4:00 pm on Friday, September 14, 2018

Excluding statutory holidays and weekends

Originals of faxed or emailed nomination documents MUST be received by the Chief Election Officer at City Hall by 4:30 pm on September 21, 2018

Nomination documents are available at the City of Chilliwack, in the Corporate Services Department during regular office hours between 8:30 am and 4:30 pm, Monday to Friday, except statutory holidays or online at www.chilliwack.com/elections.

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act* for the 2018 general local election, the following expense limits for candidates during the campaign period apply:

Councillor	\$28,020.36
Cultus Lake Park Board Commissioner	\$28,020.36
School District No. 33 Trustee	\$30,309.64

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act* for the 2018 general local election, the following third party advertising limits shall apply:

Mayor and Councillor	\$ 2,765.39
Cultus Lake Park Board Commissioner	\$ 1,401.02
School District No. 33 Trustee	\$ 1,515.48

QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older or will be on General Voting Day;
- Resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and,
- Not disqualified by the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election in British Columbia or from being nominated for, being elected to, or holding office.
