1. CALL TO ORDER

Vice Chair Westeringh called the meeting to order at 9:00 am.

2. ADOPTION OF AGENDA

Moved) That the Agenda for the February 14th, 2019 meeting of the Chilliwack Public Art

3. ADOPTION OF MINUTES

Moved) That the minutes from the November 22, 2018 meeting of the Public Art Advisory
Seconded (Committee be adopted as circulated.

5. NEW BUSINESS TO ADDRESS

Chair Westeringh opened up the meeting welcoming the new members of the committee and also welcoming back the past members then going over the Terms of Reference for the Public Arts Advisory Committee.

Next on the agenda was the roundabouts. Carol Marleau spoke to the committee about the 3 pieces of farm equipment that was received from the public callout. The pieces consisted of an older metal tractor, a bigger red tractor and the third piece was an antique mower. After significant discussion Chair Westeringh posed the question, to the committee on where they would like to place the equipment and how they would like the placement to look.

The outcome of the discussion was that the older tractor and the mower would be combined to form a visual vignette and would be placed at the Prest- Bailey roundabout. The pieces would be elevated but would be placed flat.

The hope was to have the bigger tractor placed at the Prest-Prairie Central roundabout and sited in a whimsical manner such as placed on an angle similar to the vehicle display at O’Connors.

Moved) That the Public Arts Advisory Committee move forward with recommendations that
Seconded (the City install the metal tractor with the mower at Prest- Bailey Road roundabout and the larger tractor be placed at Prest Road-Prairie Central roundabout.

All were in favour of the motion. More discussion was held regarding whether there should be another call out for more pieces. Chair Westeringh suggested we wait until this part of the roundabout projects are complete to which the committee agreed.

Carol talked about the Street Banner Program as the bracket for the banners have been donated by Chilliwack Tourism and what should be done with them. She is looking into other program and will let the committee know about best case practices from other communities. The goal is to bring a draft forward for discussion at the next committee meeting.

6. INFORMATION / DISCUSSION

Patrick asked about the new roundabout going in at Lickman Road and if there would be any artwork going in the middle of them. Chair Westeringh replied he would look into this.
