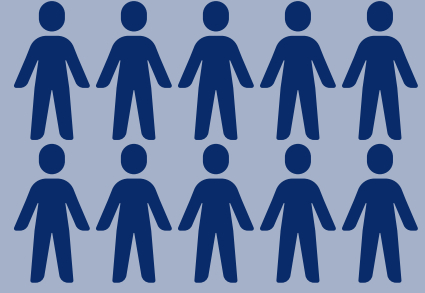


# Chilliwack Fire Department

Protects lives, property, and the environment through innovative, safe, effective, and efficient fire prevention, emergency preparedness programs, and incident response.

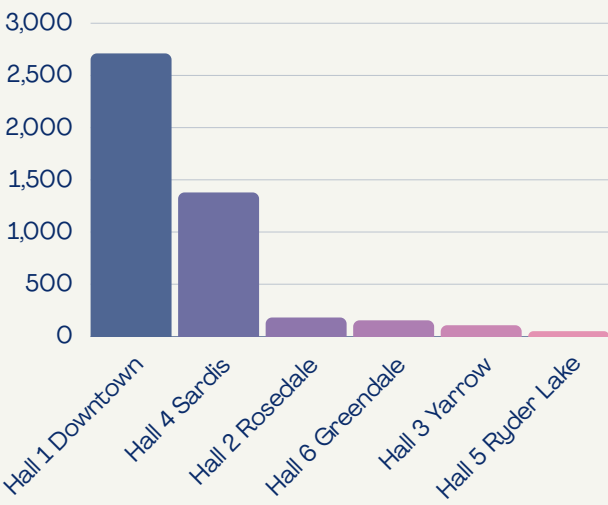
## COMPOSITE MODEL

Chilliwack has a composite public fire protection model with 45 full-time and 123 paid on-call firefighters who proudly serve our community.

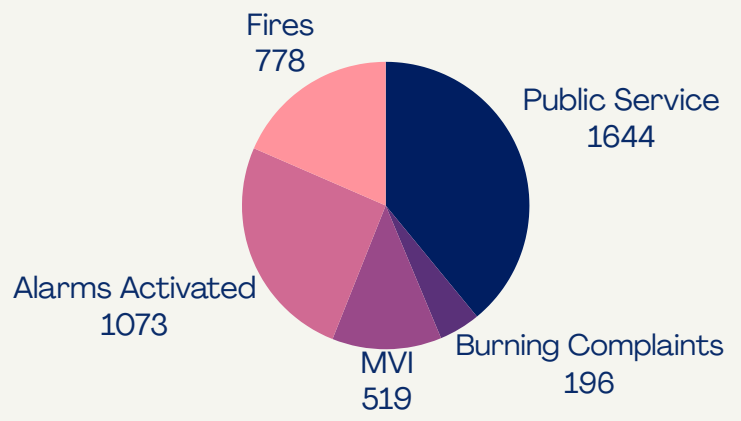


## INCIDENT RESPONSE

89% of incidents occur in the Downtown Firehall 1 and Sardis Firehall 4 response zones. These halls are staffed 24/7/365 with full-time firefighters supported 24/7/365 by 123 paid on-call firefighters.
