ELECTOR REGISTRATION

There is no need to pre-register to vote as the registration of all electors for this election will take place at the time of voting. You will be required to make a declaration that you meet the following requirements:

- 18 years of age or older on the day of registration;
- Canadian citizen;
- resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately before the day of registration;
- resident of OR registered owner of real property in the City of Chilliwack for at least 30 days before the day of registration; and,
- not disqualified by the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.

Resident electors must produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must together prove both residency and identity. The types of documents that will be accepted as identification include:

FOR IDENTITY

- BC I.D. Card
- BC Driver's Licence
- Social Insurance Card
- Credit Card / Debit Card
- Old Age Pension I.D. Card
- Passport / Citizenship Card
- BC Care Card / BC Gold Care Card
- Continued Assistance Form SDES8 (Now EA181)
- Owner's Certificate of Insurance and Vehicle Registration

FOR RESIDENCY

- BC I.D. Card
- BC Driver's Licence
- Utility Bill or other similar Credit Card Statement
- Real Property Tax Notice or BC Assessment Notice
- Owner's Certificate of Insurance and Vehicle Registration

Non-resident property electors must produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature) to prove identity; **proof** that they are entitled to register in relation to the property; and, if there is more than one owner of the property, **written consent** from the majority of the property owners is required.
