

Proof of Identity and Residency

2 Pieces of Identification are Required

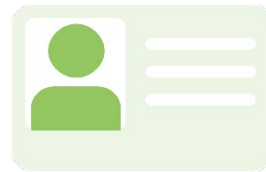
At least one must have a signature. In combination, the identification must prove both residency and identity

For your mail ballot package, you will only be required to write what TYPE of identification you are using, no numbers to be provided.

EXAMPLES OF ACCEPTABLE IDENTIFICATION:

FOR IDENTITY

- BC I.D. Card
- BC Driver's Licence
- Social Insurance Card
- Credit Card / Debit Card
- Old Age Pension I.D. Card
- Passport / Citizenship Card
- BC Care Card / BC Gold Care Card
- Continued Assistance Form SDES8 (Now EA181)
- Owner's Certificate of Insurance and Vehicle Registration



FOR RESIDENCY

- BC I.D. Card
- BC Driver's Licence
- Utility Bill or other similar Credit Card Statement
- Real Property Tax Notice or BC Assessment Notice
- Owner's Certificate of Insurance and Vehicle Registration

TAKE NOTE: IF YOUR DRIVER'S LICENCE AND CARE CARD ARE COMBINED INTO ONE CARD THAT IS CLASSIFIED AS ONLY ONE PIECE OF ID
