Bylaw No. 533

A bylaw to regulate shops in accordance
with provisions contained in the Municipal Act

The Council of the District of Chilliwack in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be cited as the "Shops Regulation Bylaw 1984, No. 533".
2. The former "Township of Chilliwack Shops Regulation Bylaw, 1958" and amendments thereto are hereby repealed.
3. In accordance with Section 923 of the Municipal Act and for the local convenience and well being of the residents of the District of Chilliwack, all classes of shops defined in Section 919 of the Municipal Act are hereby exempted completely from the provisions of Section 921 of the Municipal Act.
