Bylaw No. 5004

A bylaw to implement a Zoning Ticketing System

The Council of the City of Chilliwack in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be cited as “**Zoning Bylaw Offence Bylaw 2020, No. 5004**”.
2. “Zoning Bylaw Offence Bylaw 2006, No. 3333”, and amendments thereto are hereby repealed.

ZONING BYLAW ENFORCEMENT

3. “Zoning Bylaw 2020, No. 5000”, as amended, may be enforced by means of a ticket information in the form prescribed for the purpose of the *Community Charter*.
4. “Zoning Bylaw 2020, No. 5000”, as amended, may be enforced by means of a bylaw notice in the form prescribed for the purpose of the *Local Government Bylaw Notice Enforcement Act*.

ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS

5. The persons appointed to positions of:
 - (1) Directors of Planning and Engineering; and, Development and Regulatory Enforcement Services
 - (2) Manager of Building and Regulatory Enforcement
 - (3) Assistant Manager of Bylaw Enforcement;
 - (4) Bylaw Enforcement Officer;
 - (5) Building Inspector; and
 - (6) Members of the Chilliwack Detachment of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police;are designated as Bylaw Enforcement Officers pursuant to the *Community Charter* for the purpose of enforcing “Zoning Bylaw 2020, No. 5000”, as amended, by means of a municipal ticket information.
6. The persons appointed to positions of:
 - (1) Directors of Planning and Engineering; and, Development and Regulatory Enforcement Services;

ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS (continued)

- (2) Manager of Building and Regulatory Enforcement;
- (3) Assistant Manager of Bylaw Enforcement
- (4) Bylaw Enforcement Officer;
- (5) Building Inspector; and
- (6) Members of the Chilliwack Detachment of the Royal Canadian Mounted Police; are designated as Bylaw Enforcement Officers for the purposes of the *Local Government Bylaw Notice Enforcement Act*, in order to enforce “Zoning Bylaw 2020, No. 5000” as amended, by means of a bylaw notice.

PENALTY

7. Every person who commits an offence contrary to the provisions of “Zoning Bylaw 2020, No. 5000”, as amended, is liable, upon summary conviction, to a penalty of not less than \$500.00, and not more than \$10,000.00 in addition to the costs of the prosecution.
8. If a violation of “Zoning Bylaw 2020, No. 5000”, as amended, is enforced by means of a ticket information pursuant to the *Community Charter*, the fine for any violation is hereby established as \$1,000.00 pursuant to the *Community Charter*.
9. If a violation of “Zoning Bylaw 2020, No. 5000”, as amended, is enforced by means of a bylaw notice pursuant to the *Local Government Bylaw Notice Enforcement Act*, the penalty for any violation is hereby established as \$500.00, pursuant to the *Local Government Bylaw Notice Enforcement Act*.
10. Council hereby delegates the authority to refer to the Provincial Court any disputed ticket information, under this or another bylaw, to all the persons appointed to the positions listed in Section 5 and 6 of this Bylaw.

SEVERABILITY

11. If any portion of this Bylaw is held invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, then that invalid portion must be severed and the remainder of this Bylaw must be deemed to have been adopted without the severed portion.
