STEPS FOR STATION RENTAL

Have a green diversion station at your event in 5 simple steps:

- Fill out an application form online at www.chilliwack.com/gds or visit City Hall to pick up a form. Note that you must submit a deposit for renting the bins.*
- Submit the form by email to engineeringinfo@chilliwack.com or drop it off at City Hall.
- A City staff member will contact you to arrange the details of your station rental. Pick up the bins from City Hall at the designated time.
- Set up the diversion station(s) at your event and enjoy!
- 5. **Drop off the station bins** at City Hall within 2 days following your event.



* Please note that the deposit is fully refundable as long as you return all of the diversion station materials that you rented in the same condition as when you picked them up. If any components are missing, broken or damaged, you will be held financially responsible for their replacement. The deposit is \$50/station.

WHAT TO DO WITH YOUR COLLECTED MATERIALS

GARBAGE

Garbage can be disposed of in an onsite commercial container or dropped off at the Bailey Landfill for a fee (5940 Matheson Rd).



FOOD SCRAPS



Small quantities of organic materials in Kraft paper bags can be dropped off at the Parr Road Green Depot (45175 Parr Rd).

RECYCLABLES

A) BEVERAGE CONTAINERS



You can drop off beverage containers for a return at the Chilliwack Bottle Depot (45934 Tretheway Ave) or the Sardis Bottle Depot (45635 Lark Rd).



Alternatively, you can donate them to charity by indicating this at either of the Bottle Depots.

B) OTHER RECYCLABLES

Other recyclable items can be placed in an onsite commercial container or dropped off at the Emterra Environmental Depot (44255 Yale Rd West).

GREEN DIVERSION STATIONS

WHAT ARE THEY?

Green diversion stations are each a set of 4 plastic containers that can collect all of the waste generated at an event.

WHY MAKE YOUR EVENT GREEN?

Because it shows that you are a leader in environmental responsibility and helps prevent materials generated from going to landfill.



ARE THEY FREE?

The stations are available on loan from the City of Chilliwack to residents hosting small or large events. They are FREE to rent (just a security deposit is required)!

Stations must be returned clean and in the same condition as when they were picked up. Payment for the security deposit can be made by credit card or cheque at the City's Collections front counter. Reimbursement will be made via cheque.

HOW MANY STATIONS CAN I LOAN?

The City has 7 diversion stations available for loan. You can rent as many as you like, but make sure you plan in advance to ensure that we have enough stations on-hand for your event!

RECYCLABLES



Includes all beverage cans and bottles. iuice boxes. CapriSun and larger beverage containers.

*Note that you could host an event with 2-3 containers per station instead of 4 by not collecting food scraps and collecting deposit containers with the other recyclables.

FOOD SCRAPS



Includes all food scraps and leftovers, as well as food-soiled paper products.

GARBAGE

Includes items collected in the City's curbside recycling program (glass jars and metal cans, plastics #1-7, and paper products).



Includes wrappers. Stvrofoam containers, candy bar and chip packaging, plastic wrap and baggies, wax paper, gum and diapers.
