EVACUATION ORDER ISSUED
[November 15, 2021 at 12:30 pm]

Pursuant to the *Emergency Program Act*, an Evacuation Order has been issued by the City of Chilliwack due to immediate danger to **life safety** due to flooding. City of Chilliwack officials and other applicable agencies will be expediting this action.

The Evacuation Order is in effect for the following areas:

- 47505 Yale Road
- 47517 Yale Road
- 47535 Chartwell Drive
- 47539 Chartwell Drive
- 47543 Chartwell Drive

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO:

- You must leave the area **immediately**.
- If you need transportation assistance from the area please advise the individual providing this notice or call 604.793.2730.
- Close all windows and doors.
- Shut off all gas and electrical appliances, other than refrigerators and freezers.
- Close gates (latch) but do not lock.
- Gather your family; take a neighbour or someone who needs help if you are able.
- Take critical items (medicine, purse, wallet, and keys) only if they are immediately available.
- Take pets in pet kennels or on leash.
- Register at the Chilliwack Emergency Support Services reception centre at the Neighbourhood Learning Centre at 46363 Yale Road.
- Do not use more vehicles than you have to. Do not use the telephone unless you have to.
