

Declaration of a State of Local Emergency ORDER BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF CHILLIWACK

DATE: November 16, 2021

WHEREAS people, property and the environment are at risk of flooding in the city of Chilliwack;

And WHEREAS the threat posed by flood continues to require early warning for and preparation by those potentially or actually affected, or protection of infrastructure, property, possessions or the environment, as well as prompt coordination of response and recovery actions, or special regulations of access, activities, persons or property, to protect the health, safety or welfare of people, or to limit damage to property or the following environment within the designated areas of the City of Chilliwack circumscribed in the paragraphs following;

NOW THEREFORE:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED pursuant to Section 12 (1) of the Emergency Program Act (RS, 1996, Chap 111) that a STATE OF LOCAL EMERGENCY EXISTS in the following areas:

Chilliwack, BC

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the City of Chilliwack, its employees, servants, and agents are empowered pursuant to Section 13 (1) of the *Emergency Program Act* to do all acts and implement all procedures that are considered necessary to prevent or to alleviate the effects of the emergency.

ORDERED by the Mayor of the City of Chilliwack at 6:30 pm on November 16, 2021 to remain in force for seven days until November 23, 2021 at midnight unless cancelled by the City of Chilliwack or the Minister responsible.
