District of Chilliwack

Bylaw No. 167

A bylaw to provide for the regulation of inspections and installations of oil or propane burners and the storage facilities of flammable liquids or gasses in the District of Chilliwack

The Council of the District of Chilliwack in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw may be cited as "Flammable Liquids Burner and Storage Regulation Bylaw 1981, No. 167".
- 2. That the Bylaws cited as "The Corporation of the Township of Chilliwhack Oil Burner Permit Bylaw 1949" as amended, and the "City of Chilliwack Permit Fee Bylaw 1977, No. 1744" as amended, are hereby repealed.
- 3. The provisions of the National Fire Code of Canada 1977, as amended, shall apply to the District of Chilliwack.
- **4.** Storage of flammable and combustible liquids or gasses in excess of 45 litres, shall not be permitted on residential property.
- No contractor, owner or other person shall commence the erection or installation of an oil or propane burner, or storage facilities for flammable liquids or gasses in excess of 45 litres within the District of Chilliwack without first obtaining from the Local Assistant Fire Commissioner a permit therefor.
- **6.** Every application for a permit shall be in a form obtained from the Local Assistant Fire Commissioner.
- 7. The applicant for an oil or propane burner permit shall pay the applicable fee, as follows:

(1) Domestic \$ 5.00

(2) Commercial \$10.00

Fees for storage facilities for flammable liquids or gasses shall be as prescribed in the District of Chilliwack's Building Bylaw, from time to time in force, and amendments thereto.

8. Every person who violates or breaches or who causes or allows to be violated or breached, any of the provisions of this Bylaw, shall be guilty of an offence against this Bylaw and each day that such violation is caused or allowed to continue, shall constitute a separate offence.

9.	Any person guilty of an infraction of this Bylaw shall be liable upon summary to a fine or to imprisonment, or to both such fine and imprisonment not exceed maximum allowed by the <i>Offence Act</i> , Revised Statutes of British Columbia 1 Chapter 305 and amendments thereto.	ling the
