

Knight Road Cycling Improvements

Knight Road from Evans Road to Topaz Drive

PROJECT PURPOSE

Knight Road from Evans Road to Topaz Drive is under construction to add cycling and pedestrian safety improvements.



TIMELINE

Late 2024 (subject to weather)

- Protected bike lanes
- Transit stop refuge areas
- Paving



CONSTRUCTION DETAILS

This project includes the following upgrades:

- Retaining existing single lane vehicle traffic in either direction
- Retaining sidewalks
- New protected bike lanes in both directions
- New passenger refuge areas at bus stops
- New pedestrian refuge areas at the Luckakuck Creek crosswalk
- Drainage improvements
- Asphalt restoration works
- Line marking and signage changes



PROJECT INFORMATION

Improvements for Knight Road were needed to increase pedestrian and cyclist safety, improve accessibility, update transit stop refuge areas, and slow traffic speeds.

Necessary changes to Knight Road were identified in Chilliwack's 2017 Cycle Vision Plan, which was developed with significant public consultation. In 2022, public consultation was also conducted with residents living on or near Knight Road, and the general consensus supported these changes.

Cycling facilities, transit stop refuge areas and pedestrian refuges were designed in accordance with the current engineering standards and practices as well as Active Transportation Design Guidelines and BC Transit Infrastructure Guidelines.

Once fully complete, this project will help improve safety for everyone using Knight Road.
