Donation Guidelines

Item Condition

- All donated items must be clean, gently used, and free of stains.
- Our team will inspect every item upon arrival.
- Items that are dirty, broken, unsafe, or pose any risk will be politely declined.

Donation Limits

To keep the event manageable and fair for all participants:

<u>Clothing donations:</u> Each household may bring one standard grocery bag-sized (15 inch by 15 inch see below image) donation of clothes plus 1–2 additional items.

No clothing donations: If you are not donating clothes, you may bring up to five (5) other items.

Swap tickets—For every accepted item you donate, you'll receive a ticket that can be exchanged for another item. This helps us track how many items are being diverted from the landfill. If you run out of tickets and wish to take more items, please speak with a staff
