Salvation Army	Prevention & Diversion (Individuals & Families)	\$53,350.00	This funding is allocated to a partnership between the Salvation Army and Wilma's Transition Society to provide support for short-term or emergency financial assistance, landlord mediation and support, budgeting advice, moving costs, etc.
Salvation Army	Client Support Services	\$100,00.00	Basic needs supports (short-term food and emergency shelter assistance, clothing, footwear, culturally relevant supports, personal identification, transportation, access to technology, etc.)
Ruth & Naomi's Mission	Prevention & Diversion (Seniors)	\$53,350.00	Provides early identification and outreach to seniors at risk of housing loss, targeted financial and housing stabilization supports, and diversion and rapid rehousing assistance where homelessness has already occurred.
Cyrus Centre	Prevention & Diversion (Youth)	\$53,350.00	Will expand the Home at Last program to provide prevention, housing stabilization, and diversion supports for youth aged 16 to 24 who are at risk of homelessness and not yet ready for fully independent living.
Pacific Community Resources Society (PCRS)	Coordinated Community Outreach	\$500,000.00	This funding is allocated to a partnership between PCRS and Cyrus Centre to provide various outreach services in the community to both youth and adults.
Pacific Community Resources Society (PCRS)	Case Management Services	\$304,649.00	This funding is allocated to the PCRS – Housing Hub Program. Support staff engage in landlord mediation and support, provide prevention and case management services, conduct housing unit visits, and skill development to maintain housing.
