Mail ballot packages may be ready for pickup or mail-out	Anytime during the week of September 28, 2026

Mail ballot packages will be available for pickup at City Hall or mailed to voters during the week of September 28, 2026. Voters requesting a package for pickup must wait for email confirmation that their package is ready before coming to City Hall.

ELECTOR REGISTRATION

NO PRE-REGISTRATION REQUIRED

You do not need to pre-register to vote, and we will not distribute voter cards. Registration takes place when you vote.

To register as a resident elector, you must:

- Be 18 years of age or older when you register or be 18 years or older on General Voting Day.
- Be a Canadian citizen.
- Have been a resident of British Columbia for at least six months immediately before registering.
- Be a resident of the municipality or electoral area on the day you register.
- Not be disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or another enactment from voting in local elections and not otherwise be disqualified by law.
- Be entitled to vote and have not previously voted in this election.

Voters Living on Reserve

Eligible Indigenous and non-Indigenous electors living on Reserve are entitled to vote in general local government elections. Whether a person votes in a municipal or regional district election depends on whether the lands they live on are within a municipal boundary. For areas outside a municipal boundary, a person living on Reserve may be eligible to vote in Electoral Areas D, E and H.

NON-RESIDENT PROPERTY ELECTORS (NRPE)

To register as a non-resident property elector, you must:

- Be 18 years of age or older on the day of registration.
- Be a Canadian citizen.
- Have been a resident of British Columbia for at least six months immediately before registration.
- Be a registered owner of real property where you intend to vote for at least 30 days immediately before registration.
- Not be disqualified by law from voting.
- Be entitled to vote and have not previously voted in this election.

Additional requirements

- Must not be entitled to vote as a resident elector in the jurisdiction.
- For School Trustee elections, electors must vote where they are residents, unless they are not residents of ANY Trustee Area of that School District.
- All registered owners must be individuals. If a corporation is registered on title, none of the owners are eligible to vote as a NRPE.
- Can only register to vote in relation to one parcel of real property in the jurisdiction.
- Must hold one of the following interests in the real property:
 - Owner of a registered estate in fee simple
 - Holder of the last registered agreement for sale
 - Tenant for life under a registered life interest
 - Holder of a registered lease for a term of at least 99 years
 - Cultus Lake Park Leaseholders – a lease for a building site for a private or public use in Cultus Lake Park for a period not exceeding 21 years.
- If there is more than one individual who is a registered owner, only one of those owners may register to vote as an NRPE on behalf of that property. That person **must** obtain written consent from a majority of the individuals on title (including the person registering to vote). You can obtain consent forms before voting from our website or by contacting elections@chilliwack.com; they will also be available at voting locations.

Acceptable proof of ownership within the City of Chilliwack includes:

- Title Search
- Property Tax Notice
- Title Certificate

IDENTIFICATION

TWO PIECES OF IDENTIFICATION

Resident and non-resident property electors must present two pieces of identification. At least one must be signed.
OR one document to prove identity which contains a signature and a solemn declaration.

Accepted identification includes, but is not limited to:

- BC I.D. Card
- BC Driver's Licence
- Social Insurance Card
- Credit Card / Debit Card
- Utility Bill or similar statement
- Real Property Tax Notice or BC Assessment Notice
- Old Age Pension I.D. Card
- Passport / Citizenship Card
- BC Care Card / BC Gold Care Card
- Owner's Certificate of Insurance and Vehicle Registration
- Electronic documents (for example, e-bills) and electronic scans of paper documents are acceptable.
- BC Services Card combined with a Driver's Licence counts as ONE piece of identification.
