


Applicant: Purpose:

An Official Community Plan (OCP) amendment is proposed to update Map 12A Proposed New Parks and Map 12B Existing and Proposed Trails to support the City's Greenspace Plan as follows:

- update neighbourhood park targets in accordance with park land development achievements;
- add approximate location of proposed parks;
- add trail locations to the Eastern Hillsides area, the Vedder Mountain connection from the City owned Quarry property, and Community Forest trail connections to the Eastern Hillside trails; and,
- add a new trail (Ryder Lake to the Chilliwack River Valley).
