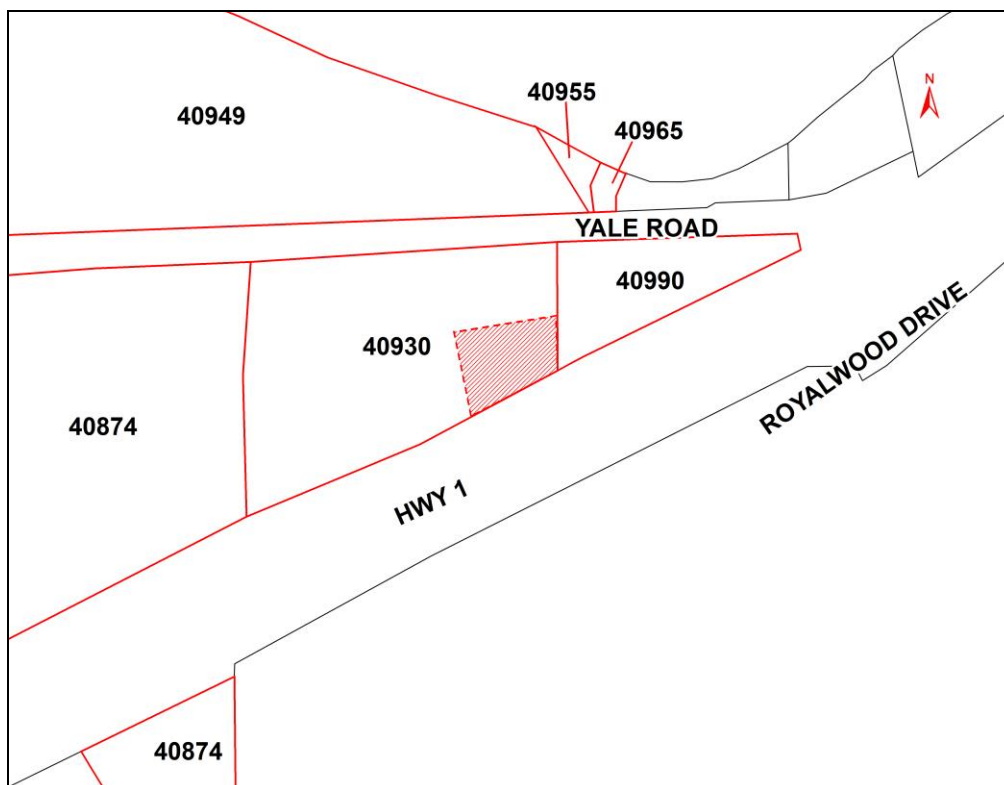
**Location:** 40930 Yale Road (a portion of)

**Purpose:** To amend the text of the AC (Agriculture Commercial) Zone.

To rezone a portion of the subject property, as shown on the map below, from an AL (Agriculture Lowland) Zone to the amended AC Zone to bring the existing RV sales and service center currently operating within the property into compliance with the City's Zoning regulations and the Agricultural Land Commission's "Non-Farm Use" approval (Resolution #89/2018).
