
TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the City of Chilliwack will hold a Public Hearing, as noted above, on the following items:

1. ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT BYLAW 2018, No. 4560 (RZ001233) DEVELOPMENT VARIANCE PERMIT DVP00990

Location:45341 Magdalena PlaceApplicant:Mr. Build ContractingPurposes:To rezone the subject property, as shown on the map below, from an
R3 (Small Lot One Family Residential) Zone to facilitate the construction of an Apressory Dwelling Unit
(ADU) in the form of a coach house.

A Development Variance Permit application is being considered concurrently with the rezoning application and requests the following variances within the proposed R1-A Zone:

- increase maximum lot onerage for a detached ADU from 75m² to 117m²;
- increase permitted maximum height for an ADU from 6.5m to 7.7m; and,



Persons who deem that their interest in the property is affected by the proposed amendment bylaw and development variance permit will have an opportunity to be heard at the Public Hearing or, if you are unable to attend, you may provide a written submission, **including your full name and address**, to the Corporate Services Department at 8550 Young Road, Chilliwack, BC, V2P 8A4 or by email to <u>clerks@chilliwack.com</u> no later than <u>4:00 p.m. on the date of the Public Hearing</u>. All submissions will be recorded and form part of the official record of the Hearing.
