1. ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT BYLAW 2018, No. 4588 (RZ001257) DEVELOPMENT VARIANCE PERMIT DVP00979

Location: 46298 Stevenson Road

Applicant: Daryl Isaac

Purposes: To rezone the subject property, as shown on the map below, from an R1-A (One Family Residential) Zone to an R3

(Small Lot One Family Residential) Zone to facilitate a future subdivision and retain the existing single family

dwelling.

An application to vary the minimum required lot depth from 25m to 23m for proposed "Lot A" and from 25m to 20m for proposed "Lot B" of the proposed R3 (Small Lot One Family Residential) Zone is being considered concurrently with the rezoning application.
