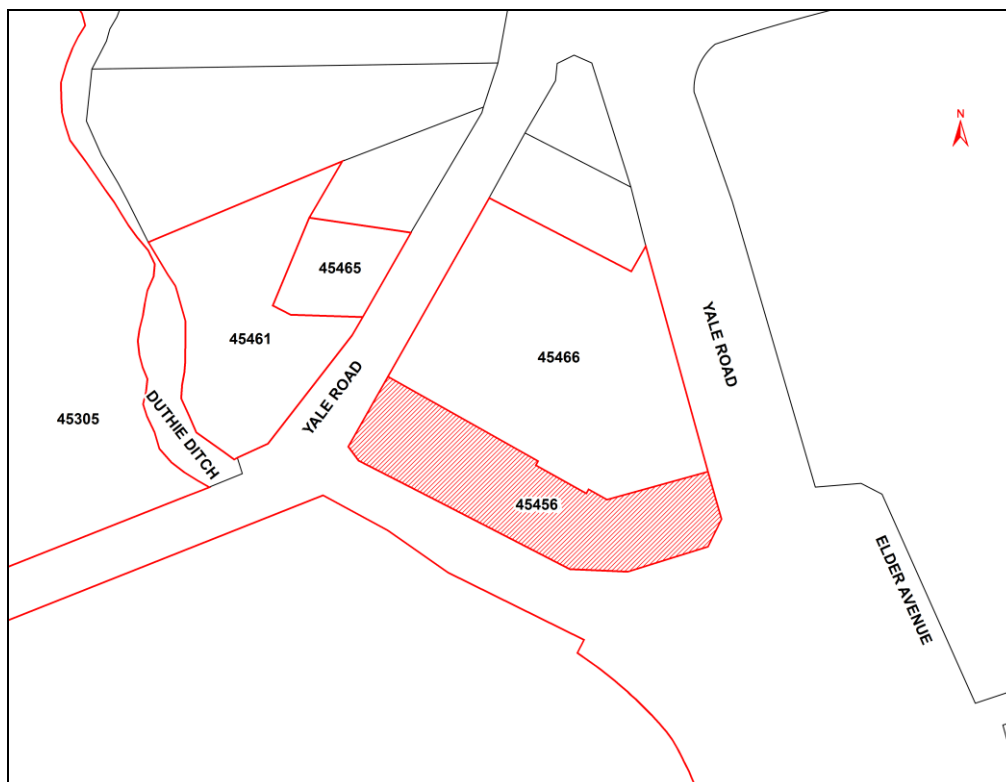
**1. OFFICIAL COMMUNITY PLAN BYLAW AMENDMENT BYLAW 2018, No. 4553 (RZ001258)**

**2. ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT BYLAW 2018, No. 4554 (RZ001258)**

**Location:** 45456 Yale Road  
**Applicant:** Melvin Lee  
**Purpose:** To rezone the subject property, as shown on the map below, from a CS2 (Tourist Commercial) Zone to an R9 (Supportive Housing and Health Contact Centre) Zone to facilitate the construction of a 20-bed recovery facility for youth ages 13-18 years old.
