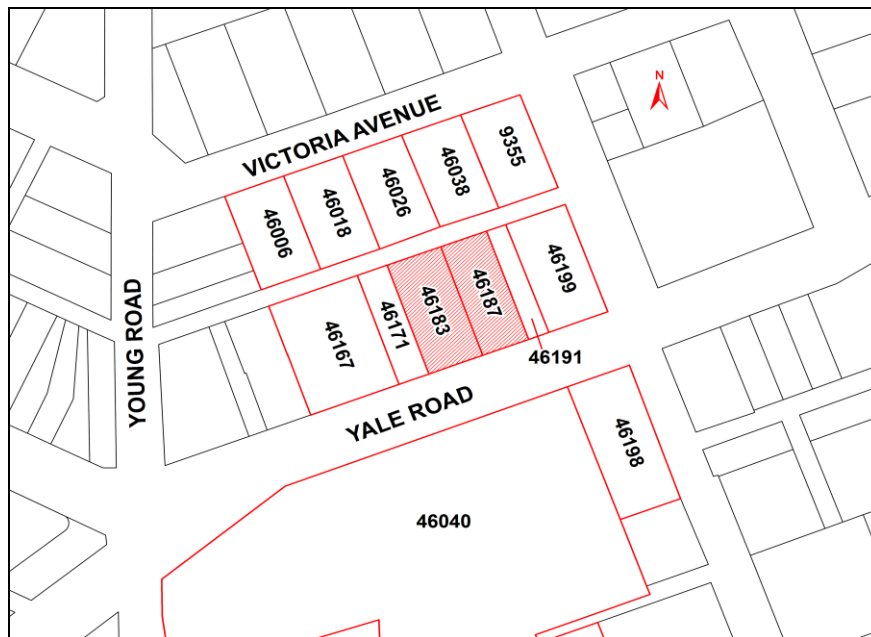
2. ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT BYLAW 2018, No. 4568 (RZ001274)

Locations: 46183 & 46187 Yale Road

Applicant: Chilliwack Community Services

Purpose: To rezone the subject properties, as shown on the map below, from a C3 (Town Centre Commercial) Zone to a new Comprehensive Development Zone, CD-28 (Comprehensive Development-28 Zone), to facilitate a mixed use development including affordable housing apartment units and commercial uses.
