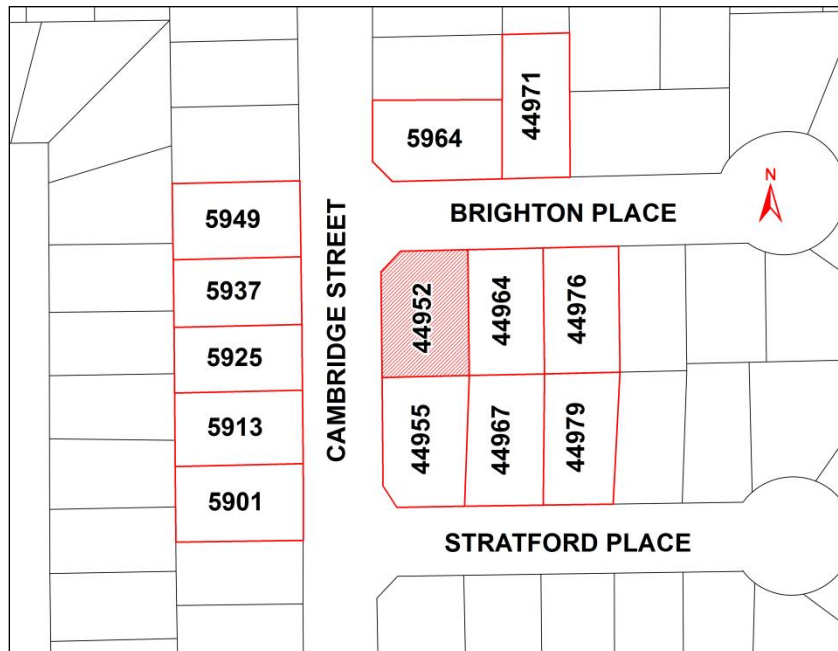
Location: 44952 Brighton Place

Purposes: To rezone the subject property, as shown on the map below, from an R1-B (One and Two Family Residential) Zone to an R1-A (One Family Residential) Zone to facilitate an addition to and the conversion of an existing workshop into a coach house.

An application to reduce the minimum rear lot line setback and interior lot line setback from 3m to 1.2m within the proposed R1-A (One Family Residential) Zone to facilitate the addition and conversion of the existing workshop into a coach house is being considered concurrently with the rezoning application.
