1. ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT BYLAW 2020, No. 4780 (RZ001283)

2. DEVELOPMENT VARIANCE PERMIT (DVP01006)

**Location:** 45657 and 45669 Yale Road (a portion of)

**Applicant:** OTG Developments Ltd.

**Purpose:** To rezone property at 45657 Yale Road and a portion of property at 45669


Yale Road from a C2 (Local Commercial) Zone to a P1 (Civic Assembly) Zone, as shown on the map below, to facilitate a future subdivision (boundary

adjustment) and an addition to an existing school.

An application to reduce the required interior side lot lines (ISLL) from 6m to  $3.3 \, \mathrm{m}$  and  $0 \, \mathrm{m}$  within the proposed P1 Zone, is being considered

concurrently with the Rezoning application.
